This retreat will focus on the three theological virtues, Faith, Hope, and Love. Points for prayer and practical application of each of the virtues will be given in order for the retreatants to deepen their devotion to Christ, the Blessed Mother, and the Church in everyday life.



Fr. Sean Raftis is a priest of the Helena Diocese. He is originally from Spokane, Washington, where he was educated in parochial elementary schools before entering Gonzaga Prep and Gonzaga University. He started studying for the priesthood in 1995 and was ordained a priest in 2005. Since ordination, Fr. Raftis has taught at various Catholic schools and universities. He has served in the Cathedral of St. Helena, Holy Cross in Townsend, MT, and is currently serving as pastor of St. Richard Catholic Church in Columbia Falls, MT, near Glacier Park. He has given several retreats at the Archbishop Brunett Retreat Center.
